

## Title: ILLUSION #4

### *Design Concept & Process:*

This is one of a series of quilts, exploring the illusion of overlapping transparent triangles. The triangles were pieced from strips of fabric, hand dyed in gradations of rainbow hues, as well as value (light to dark) gradations. A triangle which graduates from yellow/green to purple on black background, was pieced separately from a magenta to yellow triangle on a ground of light to dark purple. The two triangles were then cut into strips and sewn back together with strips of each triangle alternating to create the illusion of transparency. The center of the quilt is surrounded by a narrow binding of rainbow colored fabric.

Illusion #4 was quilted with many colors of shiny rayon thread. In contrast to the geometry of the surface design, the quilting was done in a free-form, swirling, organic design. This was done freehand, with no marking of the quilt top.
