Introduction to Art Quilts

30-45 minutes • history • inspiration • design • process

Description:

This light-hearted, fast-paced lecture is designed for people of all ages from 6-90 who have never before seen an art quilt. It introduces the audience to the use of the quilted sandwich as an art medium and shows dozens of examples that cover a wide range of styles from traditional to outrageous. I will also share a little about my personal processes and techniques to help the viewers understand and enjoy looking at quilts as art.

Room Setup:

I will provide my own projector if a digital projector if it is not available at your facility.

You will need to provide

1. Room where lights can be dimmed or turned off in front of the screen
2. Podium or music stand for notes and small table next to podium for computer.
3. Projector table or stand
4. Electrical connection
5. Large screen so everyone can see from the back of the room
6. Sound system (lavaliere mike preferred) for audiences of more than 30 people.
